### LIQUIDS

- Sistema Británico:

1 pt	2 pts	one – a pint // two pints
1 gal	2 gals	one – a gallon // two gallons

- Sistema Métrico:

1 l	2 l	one – a litre // two litres
-----	-----	-----------------------------

Litre                en Inglaterra  
Liter                en Estados Unidos

### TEMPERATURE:

20°C                twenty degrees Centigrade // Celsius  
68°F                sixty-eight degrees Fahrenheit

Fahrenheit                el agua se congela a 32°F – hiere a 212°F  
Centigrade // Celsius    el agua se congela a 0°C – hiere a 100°C

- En Europa se dan las temperaturas en Celsius.
- En Estados Unidos se dan las temperaturas en Fahrenheit.
- Para una temperatura que este bajo cero se dice:  
-5° = minus five degrees.

## MONEY:

- En Inglaterra:

1p	2p	one p // two p (pronunciación informal 'pee') one penny // two pence (mas formal)
£1	£2	one pound // two pounds
£1 = 100 p		one pound is one hundred pence
£1.20		one pound and twenty (pence)

- En Estados Unidos:

1 c	2c	one cent // two cents
\$1	\$2	one dollar // two dollars
\$1 = 100 c		one dollar is one hundred cents
\$2.12		two dollars and twelve (cents)

MONEY

- Para preguntar sobre el precio de algo, utilizamos:

HOW MUCH IS/ARE.....?

HOW MUCH DO/DOES ..... COST?

How much is that red bike?

It's £100.

How much does that computer cost?

It costs £1000

How much are those biscuits?

They're \$3.00

How much do CDs cost?

They cost £12

- Para preguntar por cambio, por ejemplo de un billete de £10 (note = billete), podemos preguntar :

I need a 20p coin for the phone.

**Have you got any change?**

Excuse me, **can you change this £10 note for me?**

- Llamamos la moneda metálica : A COIN – COINS.

- Llamamos los billetes: A NOTE – NOTES.
