

SU FORMA:

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + WILL HAVE + BEEN + GERUNDIO
NEGATIVA	SUJETO + WON'T HAVE + BEEN + GERUNDIO
INTERROGATIVA	WILL + SUJETO + HAVE+ BEEN + GERUNDIO?
RES. CORTAS	YES, PRONOMBRE SUJETO + WILL HAVE BEEN NO, PRON. SUJETO + WON'T HAVE BEEN

FORMACIÓN

SU USO:

- Este tiempo verbal se utiliza para hablar de acciones que continuarán en el futuro. Normalmente indicamos la duración y utilizamos by... o una fecha en el futuro:

This time next year Kim will have been living in China for five years.
(habrá estado viviendo....)

In 2010 my sister will have been driving a taxi for 20 years.
(habrá estado conduciendo).

- Cuidado no se utiliza el Future Perfect Continuous con los STATE VERBS pero el Future Perfect Simple:

By 2010 I will have known Mike for over thirty years!
(NOT: by 2010 I will have been knowing....)

- Utilizamos el Future Perfect Continuous con las expresiones :

By tomorrow	This time tomorrow
By next year	This time next year
By next week	This time next week
By next month	This time next month
By Monday	Next Monday
