

SU FORMA

- **PRESENTE:**

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + NEED/NEEDS TO + VERB INF SIN TO
NEGATIVA	SUJ + DON'T/DOESN'T NEED TO + VERB INF - TO
INTERROGATIVA	DO/DOES + SUJ + NEED TO + VERB INF – TO?

- **PAST SIMPLE:**

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + NEEDED TO + VERB INF SIN TO
NEGATIVA	SUJ + DIDN'T NEED TO + VERB INF - TO
INTERROGATIVA	DID + SUJ + NEED TO + VERB INF – TO?

- **FUTURE:**

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + WILL NEED TO + VERB INF SIN TO
NEGATIVA	SUJ + WON'T NEED TO + VERB INF - TO
INTERROGATIVA	WILL + SUJ + NEED TO + VERB INF – TO?

- **GOING TO:**

AFIRMATIVA	SUJ + AM/IS/ARE GOING TO NEED TO + VERB INF SIN TO
NEGATIVA	SUJ + AM NOT/ISN'T/AREN'T GOING TO NEED TO + VERB INF - TO
INTERROGATIVA	AM/IS/ARE + SUJ + GOING TO NEED TO + VERB INF – TO?

- **PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE:**

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + HAVE/HAS NEEDED TO + VERB INF SIN TO
NEGATIVA	SUJ + HAVEN'T/HASN'T NEEDED TO + VERB INF - TO
INTERROGATIVA	HAVE/HAS+ SUJ + NEEDED TO + VERB INF – TO?

SU USO:

- Utilizamos NEED TO cuando es necesario hacer algo:
I have an important test tomorrow, so I need to study.
(necesito estudiar)
- Utilizamos la forma negativa de NEED TO cuando no es necesario hacer algo:
Louise doesn't need to buy bread. We've got a lot.
- Utilizamos DIDN'T NEED TO + VERB INFINITIVO SIN TO cuando alguien no tuvo la necesidad de hacer algo:
I didn't need to water the garden as it had just rained.

SU USO : MODAL PERFECT:

- Utilizamos **NEEDN'T HAVE + PARTICIPIO PASADO** cuando alguien hizo algo y no era necesario hacerlo:
You needn't have studied for a test, we're not going to do one.
