### SU FORMA:

AFIRMATIVA	SUJETO + HAD BETTER + INFINITIVO SIN EL TO
NEGATIVA	SUJETO + HAD BETTER NOT + INFINITIVO SIN EL TO
INTERROG.	HAD + SUJETO + BETTER + INFINITIVO SIN EL TO?

FORMACIÓN

### SU USO:

- Cuando hacemos una pregunta con HAD BETTER + INFINITIVO SIN TO y queremos contestar con una respuesta corta, utilizamos solo el HAD – HADN'T:

Had I better leave now?

Yes, you had.

No, you hadn't.

- Normalmente para hacer preguntas utilizamos SHOULD en vez de HAD BETTER:

Should I leave now?

Yes, you should

No, you shouldn't.

- Se usa para dar consejos:

Your bike is very old. You'd better buy a new one if you want to win the race (sería mejor que...)

- Se usa para decir que deberíamos o no hacer:

I've got a headache. I'd better take an aspirin, and I'd better not go to the concert.
