

POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS:

MINE -	(el)mío
YOURS -	(el)tuyo/suyo
HERS -	(el)suyo de ella
HIS -	(el)suyo de el
-	
OURS -	(el)nuestro
YOURS -	(el)vuestro
THEIRS -	(el)suyo de ellos/ellas

- Utilizamos un pronombre posesivo en vez de un adjetivo posesivo + sustantivo:
That book is my book - that book is mine.
That dog is hers – that dog is her dog.

- Nunca acompaña un sustantivo:
That book is mine - ~~That book is mine book~~

- En inglés se dice: A friend + possessive pronouns = un amigo + pronombre posesivo
A friend of mine un amigo mío
A friend of his/hers un amigo suyo
A friend of ours un amigo nuestro....

- WHOSE? = De quién?

WHOSE + OBJETO POSEIDO + IS/ARE + THIS/THESE?
WHOSE + OBJETO POSEIDO + IS/ARE + IT/THEY?

Whose book is this? – De quién es este libro?
Whose book are these? – De quién son estos libros?
Whose racket is it?- De quién es la raqueta.
Whose shoes are they? – De quién son los zapatos?
Whose are these? – De quién son éstos?
Whose's this? – De quién es esto?

- Respuesta a la pregunta Whose:
 - It's mine – Es mío
 - It's hers – Es suyo.
 - They're John's – Son de John.
 - They're John's shoes – Son los zapatos de John.
 - It's Jenny's racket – Es la raqueta de Jenny.
