

A LITTLE – LITTLE – VERY LITTLE:

• A LITTLE + SUSTANTIVO INCONTABLE = UN POCO – UN POCO DE:

- Da una idea positiva:

She drank **a little water** – bebió un poco de agua.

She speaks **a little french** – Habla un poco de francés.

Can you speak French? **A little.** – Hablas francés?Un poco.

• LITTLE + SUSTANTIVO INCONTABLE = POCO – POCA:

- Da una idea negativa:

There was **little food** in the fridge. – Hay poca comida en la nevera.

• VERY LITTLE + SUSTANTIVO INCONTABLE = MUY POCO:

She eats very little – come muy poco.

A FEW – FEW – VERY FEW:

• A FEW + SUSTANTIVO PLURAL = UNOS POCOS – UNOS CUANTOS:

- Da una idea positiva:

I wrote **a few letters** – escribí unas cuantas cartas.

Have you got any cigarettes? **A few** – Tienes cigarrillos?unos pocos.

• FEW + SUSTANTIVO PLURAL = POCOS – POCAS:

- Da una idea negativa:

There were **few people** on the beach – Había pocas personas/poca gente en la playa.

• VERY FEW + SUSTANTIVO PLURAL = MUY POCOS:

She makes very few mistakes – hace muy pocas faltas.
