

INTRODUCTION :

- Un adverbio es una palabra u oración que nos dice más sobre el verbo. Podemos distinguir varios adverbios:
 - Adverbs of manners (modo) : How?
 - Adverbs of time (tiempo) : When?
 - Adverbs of frequency (frecuencia) : How often?
 - Adverbs of place (lugar) : Where?
 - Adverbs of degree (grado): How much?

- También hay oraciones adverbiales, que dan la opinión del hablante sobre toda la oración.
Leo danced in a lively way.

- Los adverbios siguen un orden en la oración:

(TIME) – MANNER – PLACE – (TIME)

Bill worked hard at school yesterday.
Yesterday Bill worked hard at school.
She drives fast on main roads in the evening.

ADVERBS OF TIME – FORM:

- Algunos adverbios de tiempo:
Yesterday – today – tonight – the other day – at the moment – last week – this week – next week – tomorrow – late – early....

ADVERBS OF TIME – USO:

- Los adverbios de tiempo nos muestra cuando algo aconteció, acontece, acontecerá.

- Normalmente ponemos un adverbio de tiempo AL PRINCIPIO O FINAL DE LA ORACIÓN:

Yesterday, I saw her at the supermarket.

I saw her at the supermarket, yesterday.

She's studying Russian this year.

This year she's studying Russian.
